

## iTouch Security Checklist

<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Check for software updates:</b> Go to Settings > General > Software Update (Download and Install any updates available; you'll need to be connected to WIFI to do this) Use MISD Guest WiFi.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Set up Apple ID:</b> Settings > Store > Sign in > Use Existing Apple ID > Enter your grade level Apple ID and password (If your old Apple ID is still entered, select it, sign out, then sign back in with new one. (choose "use existing" when putting in new ID)
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Automatic Downloads:</b> While still in store, to allow automatic downloads to all devices from this Apple ID, push the button by Apps. The blue "on" button will appear.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Find My Device:</b> Settings > iCloud > Select "Allow iCloud to use the location of your iPod Touch" > Turn off weather, etc., leaving only "Find my iPod" turned on. This will allow you to find the iPod by GPS if it ever goes missing. Each time you select off you will get the choice to either "Keep on My iPod touch" or "Delete from My iPod". Select "Delete from My iPod". Once everything is turned off, double check that below the "Storage & Backup" option it says "iCloud Backup is OFF".
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Download iBooks:</b> App Store > When suggested Free Apps pop up select close > Search > Download iBooks (You may also want to download Podcasts or iTunesU if you think you may use these apps with your students.) iBooks must be downloaded now to set up the appropriate restrictions later in this process.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Set Restrictions Passcode:</b> Settings > General > Restrictions. Click "Enable Restrictions". Set up a 4 number passcode using your campus code. Do not give this number to any of your students! (While looking at General and Restrictions, make sure that under General "Passcode Lock" is set to off which should be the default setting.) <b>Steps 8 - 17 are all found under Restrictions: Allowed Content.</b>
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict iTunes:</b> Turn off iTunes (which will automatically turn off Ping) and iBook Store.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict Installing/ uninstalling apps:</b> The list you see shows what permissions you are giving your students. Turn off "Deleting Apps." Leave Installing Apps on so the Automatic Download option works correctly for installing apps.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict Music:</b> Under "Allowed Content" select Music and Podcasts. Turn off Explicit.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict Movies:</b> Under "Allowed Content" select Movies. Check ONLY G.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict TV shows:</b> Under "Allowed Content: select TV Shows. Select "Don't Allow TV shows."
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict Books:</b> Under "Allowed Content" turn off Sexually Explicit Content.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict Apps:</b> Under "Allowed Content": select Apps. Check 9+
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict In-App Purchases:</b> Under "Allowed Content" deselect so button is set to "Off".
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Require Password:</b> Select Immediately.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict Location changes:</b> This step continues under Restrictions: Privacy options. Click Location Services. Then select "Don't Allow Changes."
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict Account Changes:</b> This step continues under Restrictions: Under "Allow changes", click Accounts. Select "Don't Allow Changes."
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Restrict Game Center:</b> Under "Game Center" deselect multiplayer games and adding friends.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Accessibility:</b> If you'd like to enable a feature that will read selections to your students, go to General > Accessibility, then select Speak Selection, turn it on and choose speaking rate. (While under Accessibility make sure assistive touch is off which is the default setting.)
